Arts & Crafts

Min 10 max 20

Cost \$20.00

Join us for this exciting elective where we will be exploring crafting and painting and doing all sorts of fun things.

Cooking grade 3 to 6 only

Max 20

Cost \$20.00

Have you always wanted to cook like a chef? Amaze your family and friends with your cooking skills as you join Madame and Monsieur in the Riverside kitchen. Sessions will cover delectable themes such as: healthy entrées, desserts and international flavours. One or two of the afternoons will be hosted by local chefs. **This is only for grade 3 students as this is offered to the 4, 5 and 6 students as well.**

Cross Country Skiing

Max 12

Cost \$52.00

Students will be instructed in classic cross-country skiing and skate skiing techniques and will be given the opportunity to try a variety of groomed trails. These sessions will help prepare students who are interested in participating in and training for the North Muskoka ski races that will also be held at Arrowhead.

Dance

Min 10 to - Max 40

Cost \$30.00

This program is through the Muskoka Dance Academy and enables students to try different styles of dance in a real studio atmosphere with hardwood floors, mirrors, mats and a professional sound system. Over the 4 weeks students will be taught proper techniques and styles such as Jazz, Ballet, Hip Hop, Musical Theatre (singing, acting & dancing), prop work, imagination and team building. **We need 10 students to run this elective.**

Gymnastics

Cost \$58.00

Gymnastics is program designed for fun and the fundamentals of fitness. Groups will be divided according to ability and age. Classes will be coached by a certified Bracebridge Limberettes coach.

Music

Min 8 - Max 20

Cost \$75.00

Students get a chance to learn more about who Beethoven was, explore some of his music in fun and creative ways, compose their own piece, and much more. Snack is provided each day. Kids end up with a take-home booklet about Beethoven, a t-shirt, and a few other hands-on music creations. Music experience is NOT required to participate in this elective.

Skating
